- Mirae Asset applies extensive bottom-up research methods in a team-based setting to identify investment opportunities.

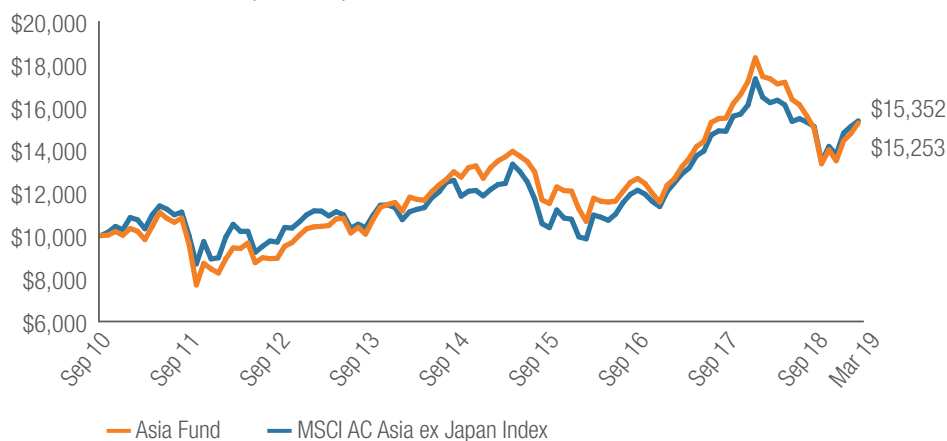

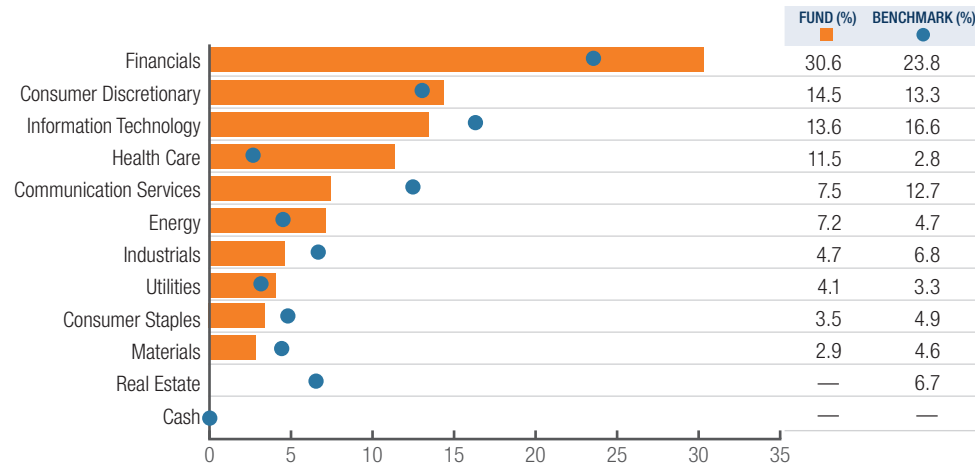

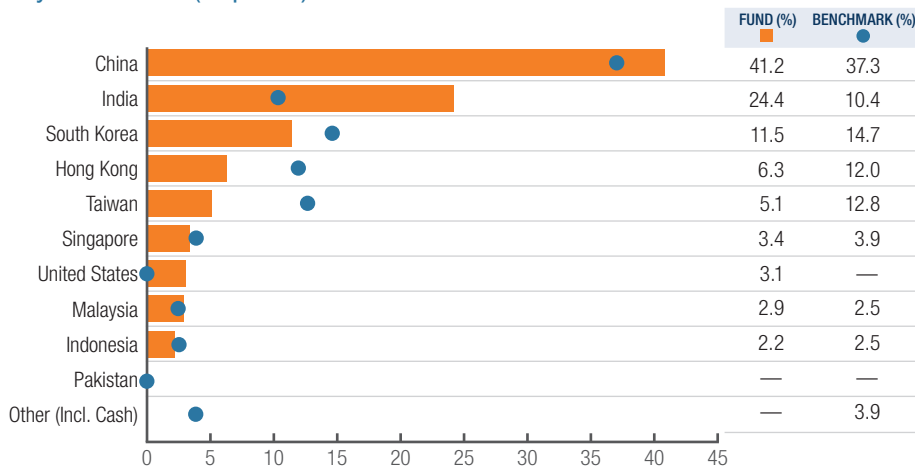
